2016 HERITAGE AWARDS APPLICATION

Webmaster Beth McKechnie is compiling an application on behalf of AMMPT for a 2016 Heritage Award. The application focuses on Cinema Web which covers the history of the availability of film to the public in Western Australia. Members may be aware Cinema Web covers a short history of each facility where films were shown from the very first days of moving pictures to the 1980's. The core information comprising Cinema Web was compiled through the work of researcher Dr. Ina Bertrand who was assisted through the advice provided at that time by AMMPT members. The history of film viewing in around 600 towns or centres in Western Australia is covered. Over the years drive-ins theatres and picture halls were closed or transformed for other community increasing the significance of Cinema Web as a record of our culture and the past.
